Hero Description: The late Josiah Mooketsi Rasego was born on the 30th August 1930 in Bethanie, Free State. He was the eldest son of the Late Pastor Ephraim and Disebo Rasego. He entered in Holy matrimony with Disebo Lydia Rasego in 1958.

Education: He received his primary education in Bethanie. He went to Moroka Missionary High School in Thaba' Nchu, where he completed his High School- and Teacher Courses. He started to teach at the Thabong Primary School. He left the teaching profession in 1958 and went to Marang Theological College in Rustenburg, Transvaal.

Church Activities: He was ordained into the Full-time Ministry in Kimberley (1972). He served in Postmastburg and also in Parishes in Kuruman and some surrounding rural areas. He was also involved in community activities such as a councillor. In 1980 he was transferred to the Parish of St George (Kimberley). He completed the church structure which was incomplete. He was the chairman of ELCSAMO in the COD, a member of IDAMASA and also served as a rural field worker in the Northern Cape Council of Churches, as well being an Electoral Officer for the Independent Electoral Commission (IEC). In 1988 he was a part of the delegation that went to Germany after the establishment of a Partnership between Kassel-East and the Northern Cape. He served for fifteen years as minister and went on retirement in 1995.
