

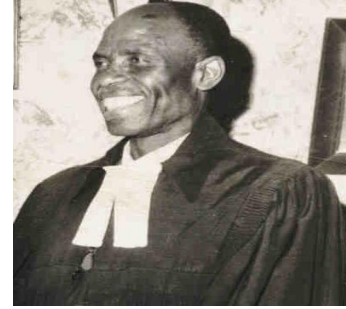

Hero Description: The Late the Pastor Samson Rathule Nthuping was born on the 30th October 1904. He was the eldest son of the late Rev. Mikia and Tabitha Nthuping. He entered in Holy matrimony with Eva, Kedilatile Bodigelo and was blessed with six children (5 boys and 1 daughter). His first wife died in 1966, but he remarried in 1968 with Rebecca Mathane who had 1 daughter. He is survived by 2 sons, 1 daughter and 1 step daughter, 24 grandchildren and 36 great grandchildren

Education: He received his primary education at Frankfort Primary School. He did his Secondary Education at Potchefstroom and left school after Form II (Std 8). He joined the Lutheran Church and was appointed Principal of a School at Wanda District, Hopetown. He attended some periodical ministerial courses conducted by the late Rev. Dr. Baumbach, held at Bethany in the Free State.

Church Activities: He was ordained into the Full-time Ministry in Bethany (16th January 1944). He served as Pastor and Principal at the following places in Bloemfontein: Soutpan District, Brandfort and Bethany. He was later transferred to Kimberley and served at the Parish of St. Martin. In 1962 he was elected as Dean of the Free State and was transferred to Bloemfontein. In 1975 He was transferred to Koffiefontein, where he retired in 1984 at the age of 80 years.
